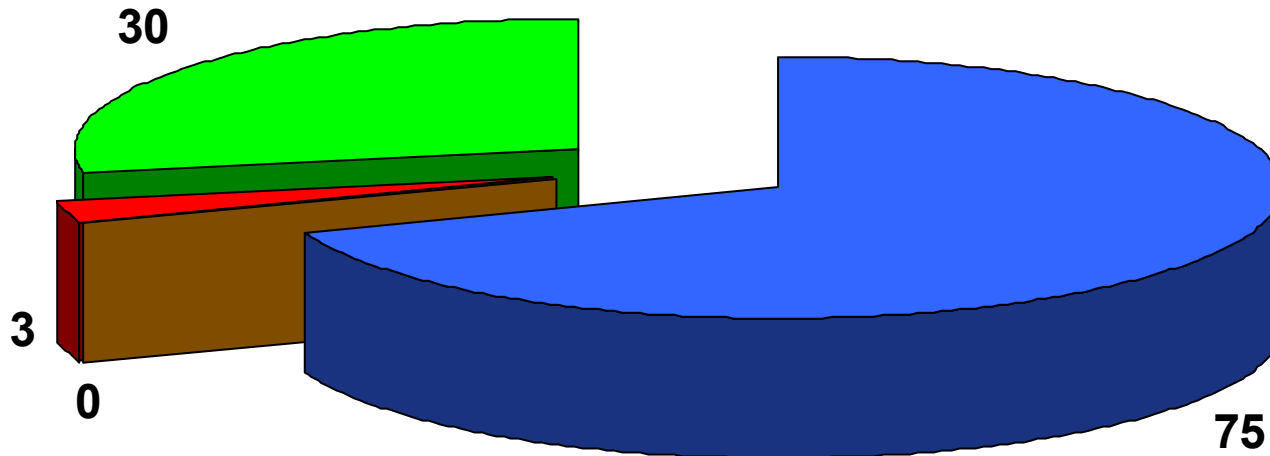

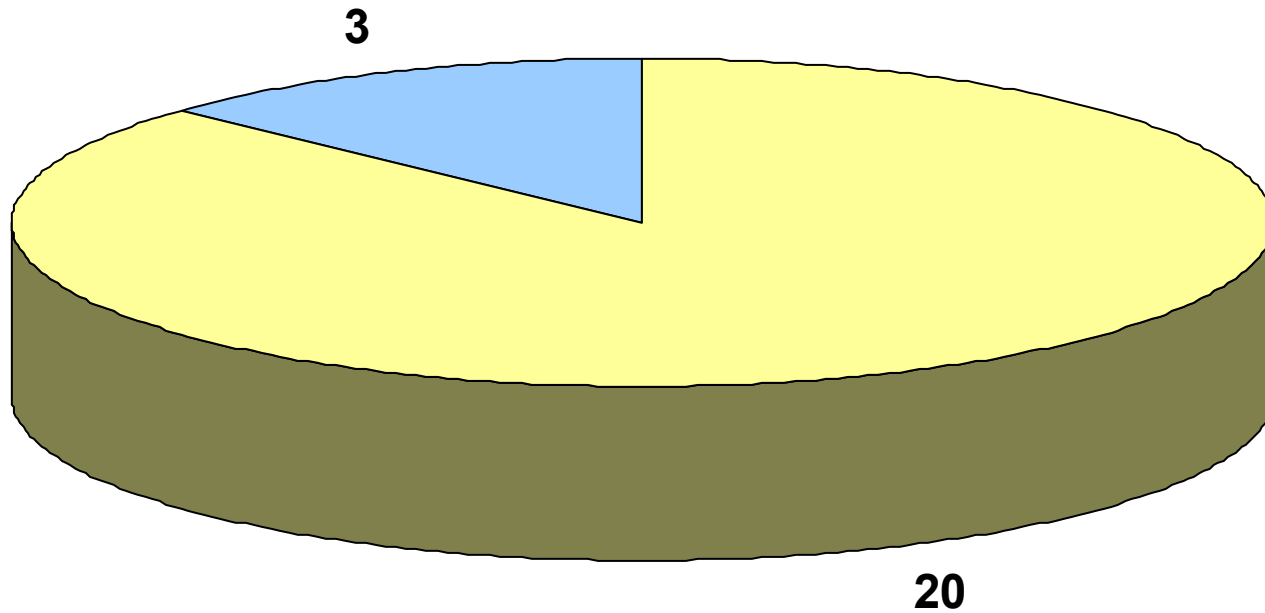

Gender of Graduates

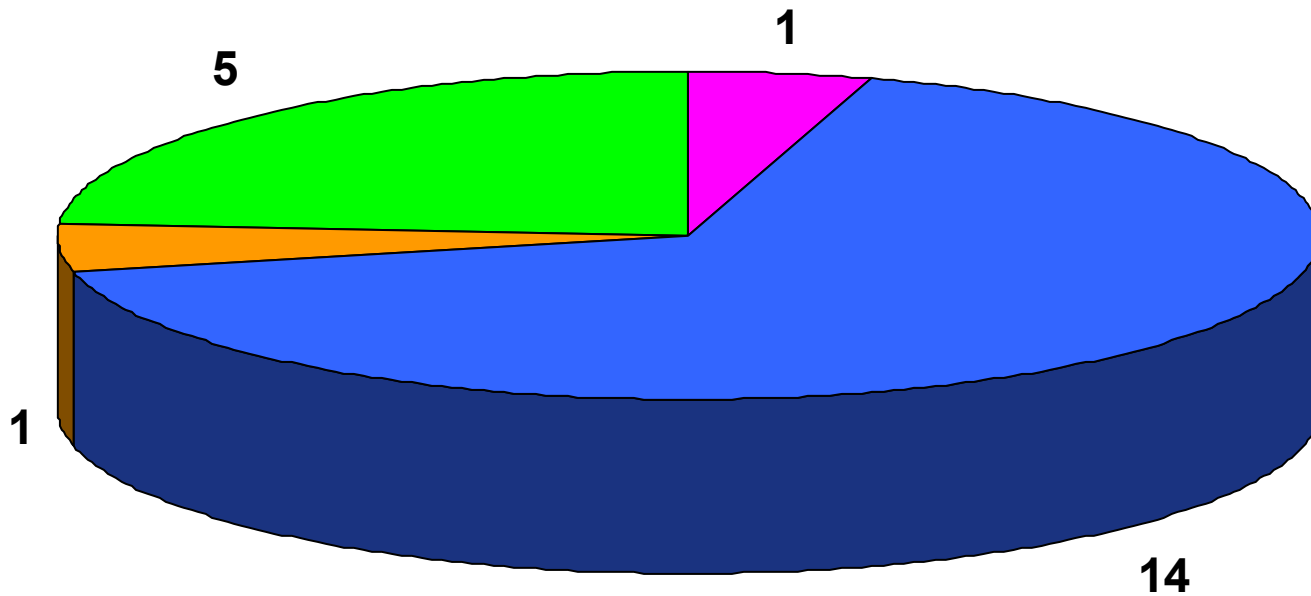
23 Respondents Reporting Gender

Age of Graduates

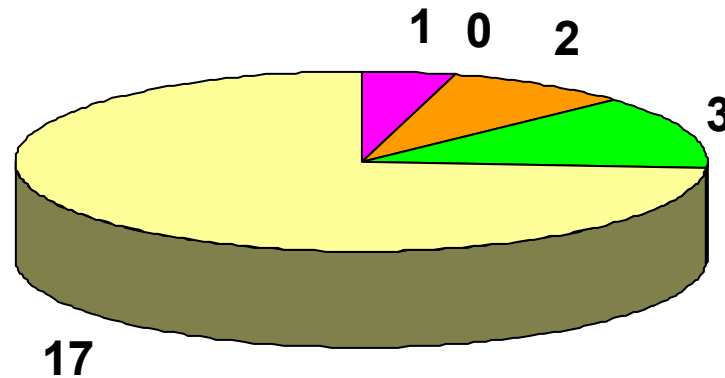

Minority Status of Graduates

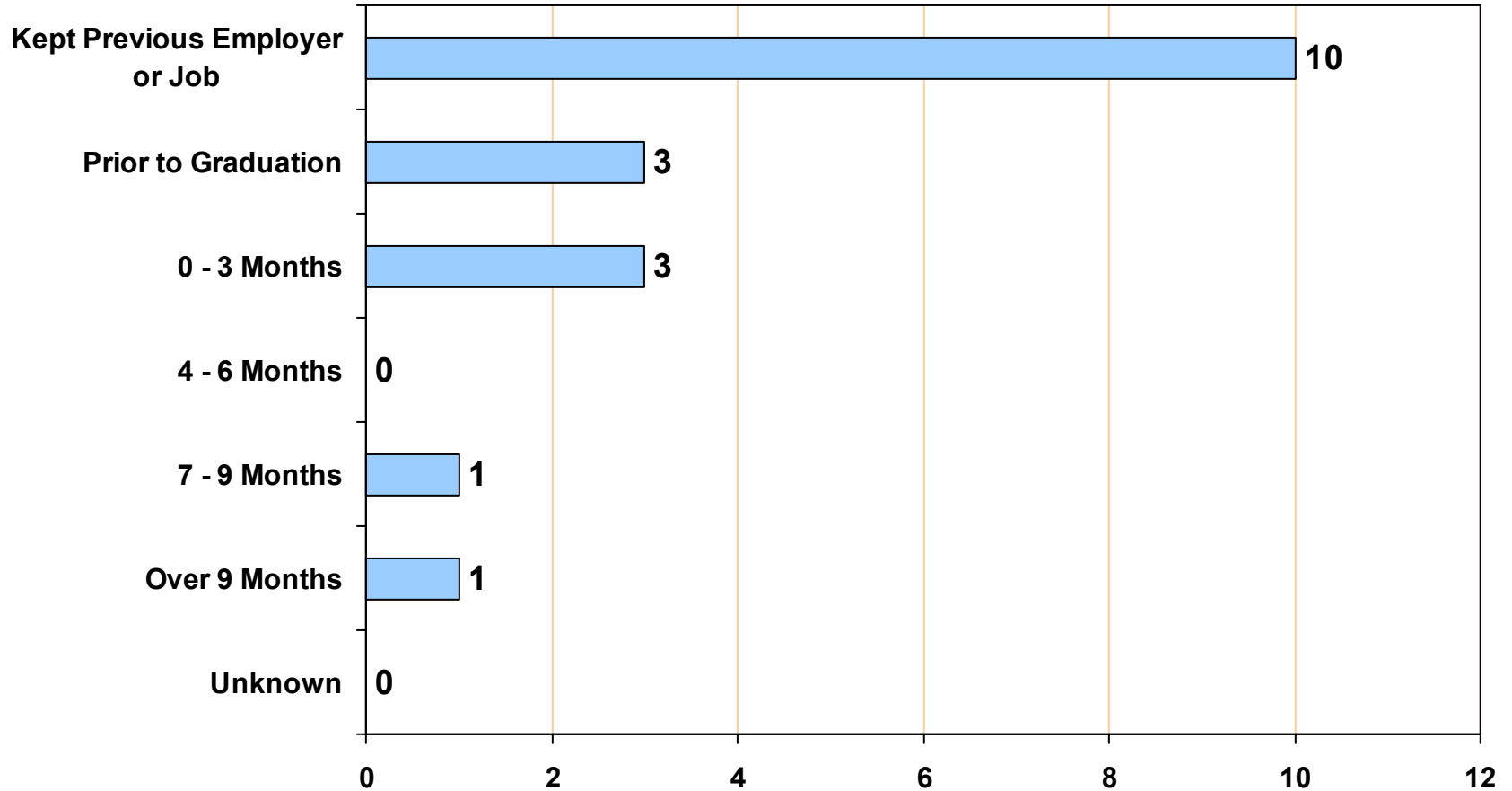

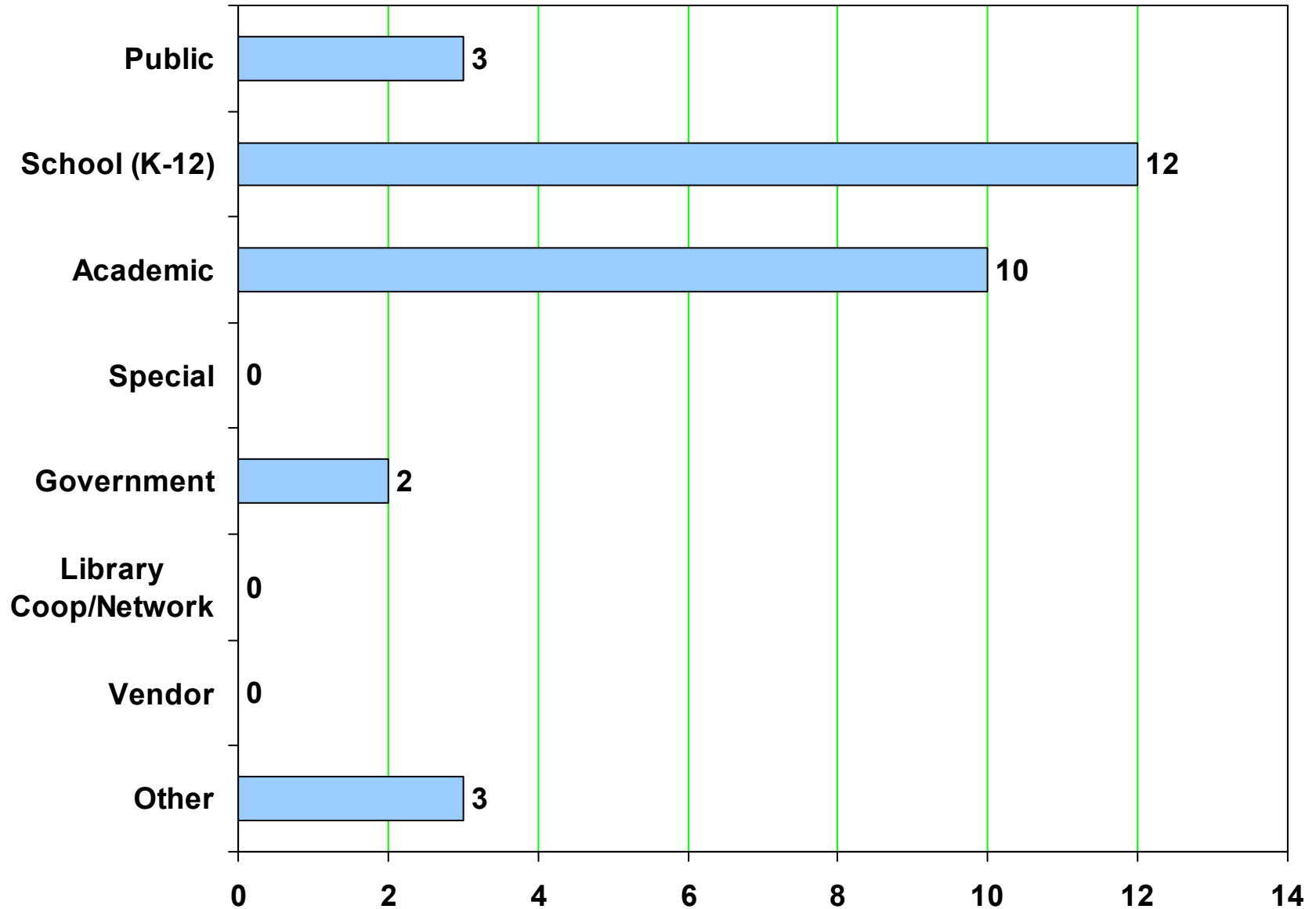
Time to First Employment

18 Reporting Full-Time Employment Information



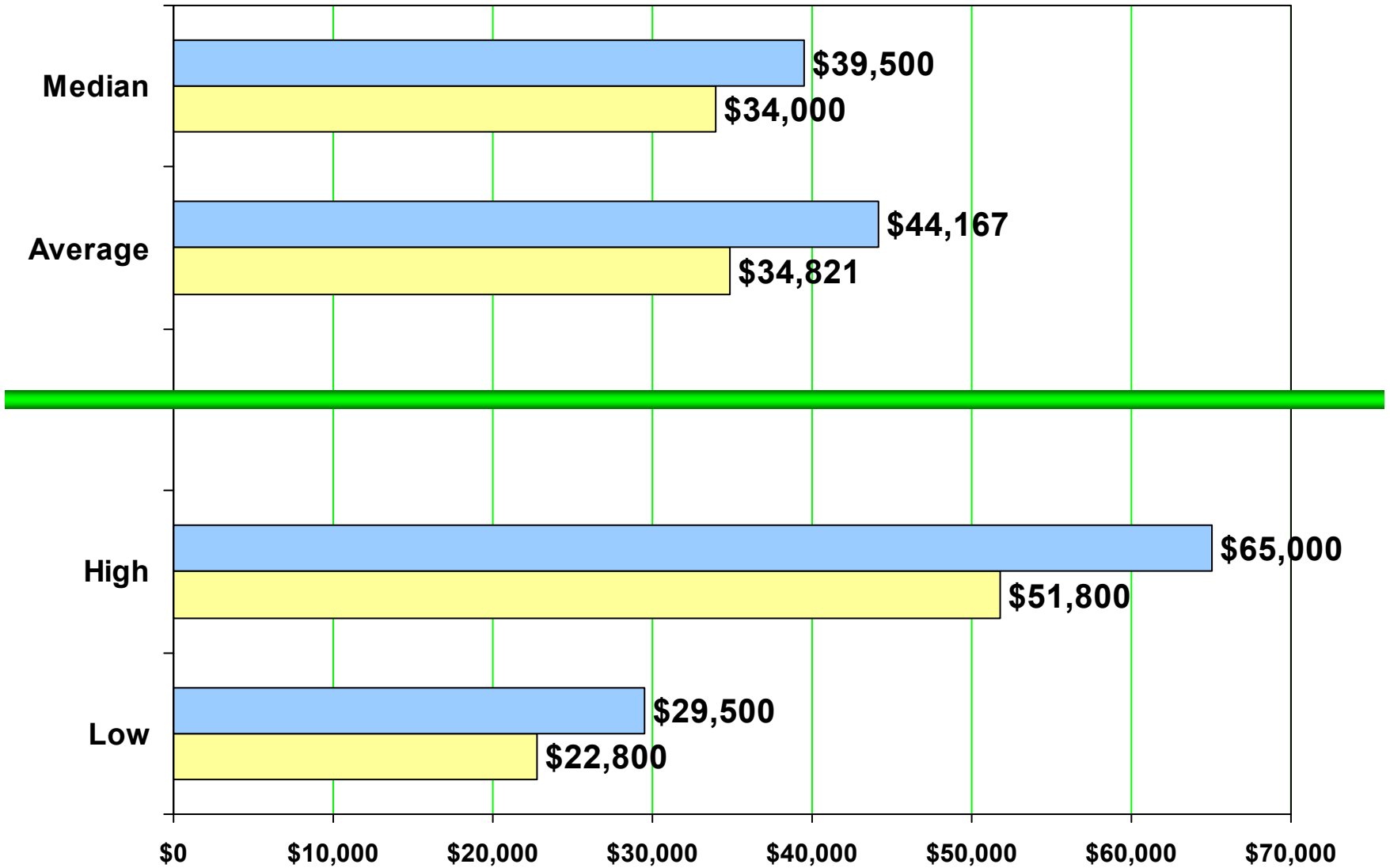
Employment by Type of Organization

30 Graduates Reporting Employment



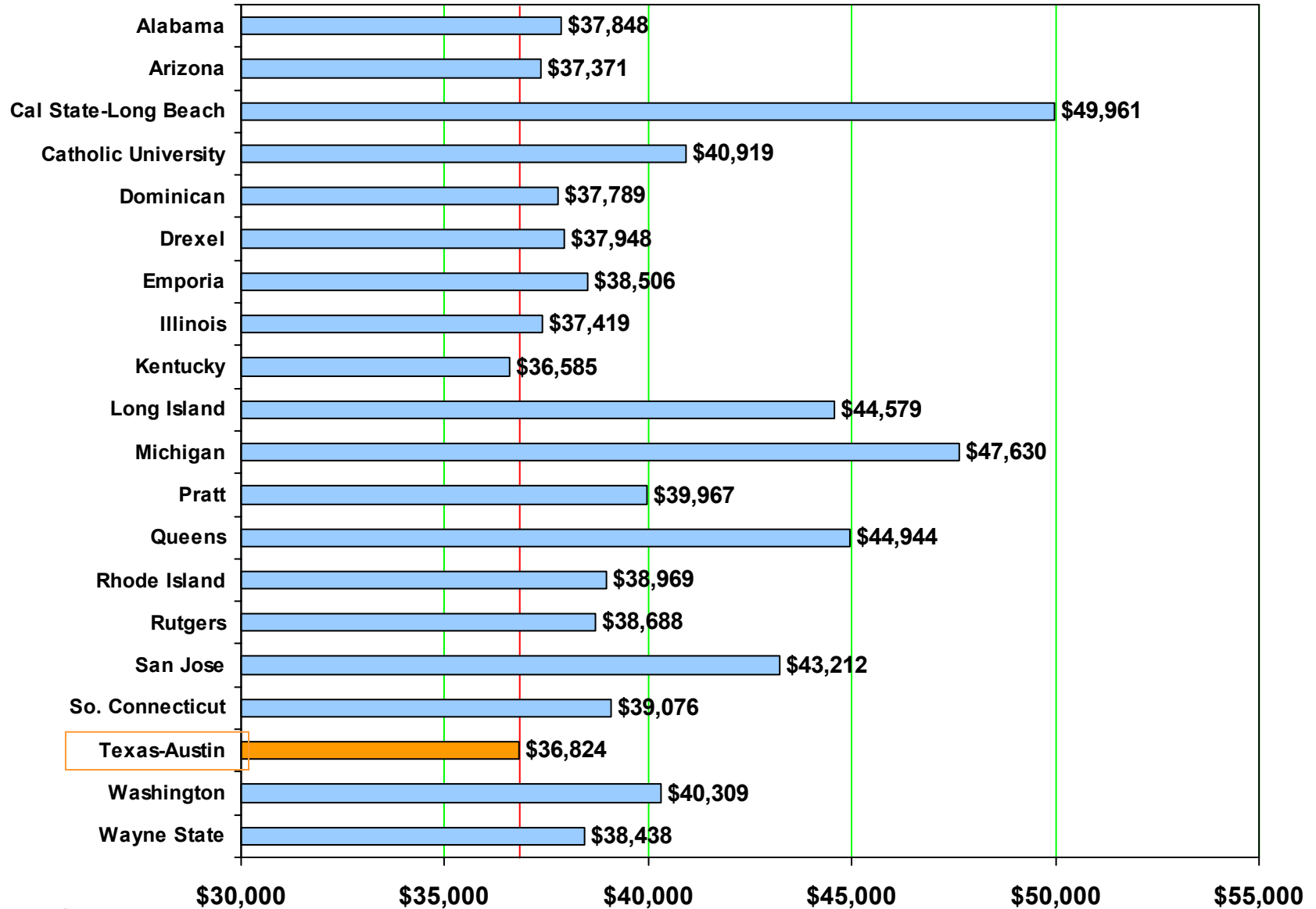
Salaries by Gender
