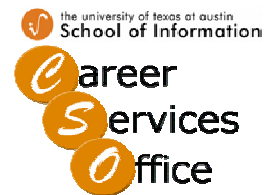

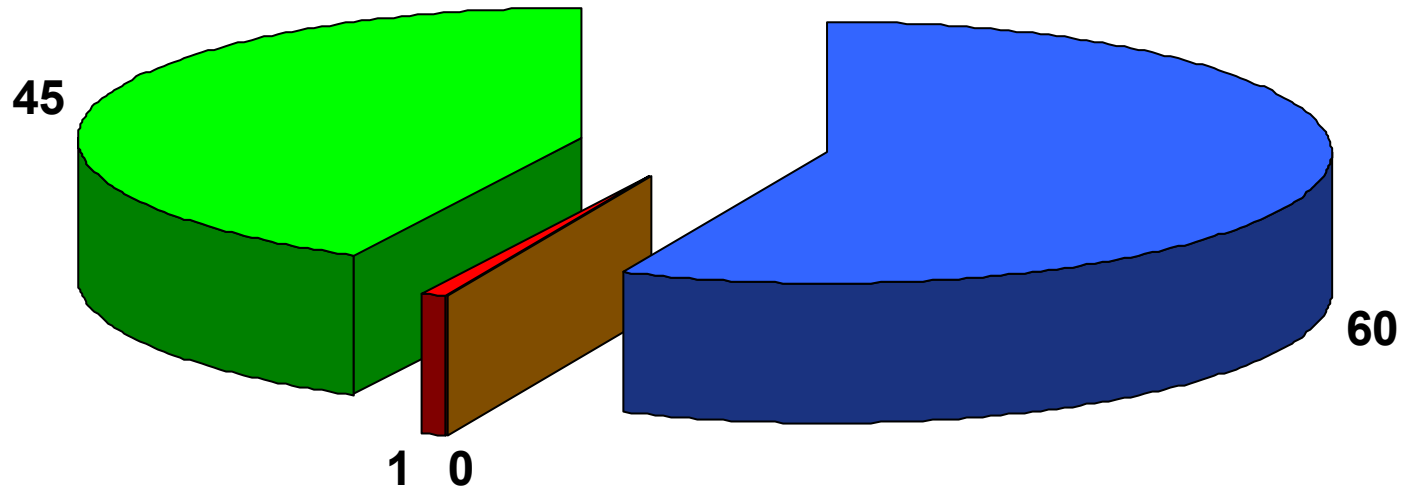

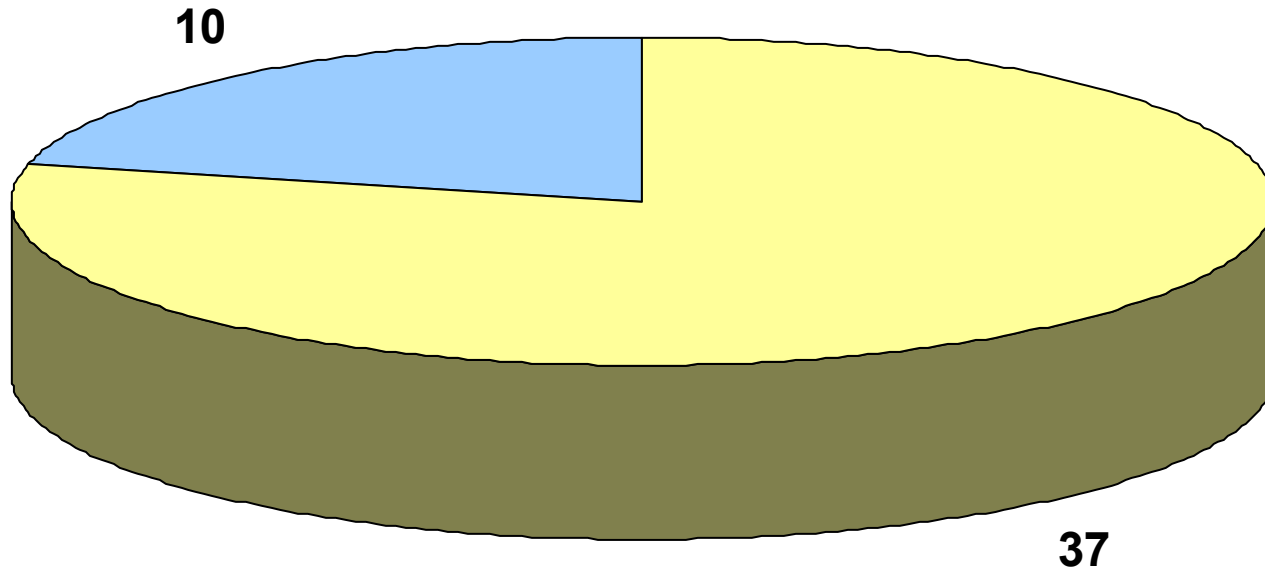

Gender of Graduates

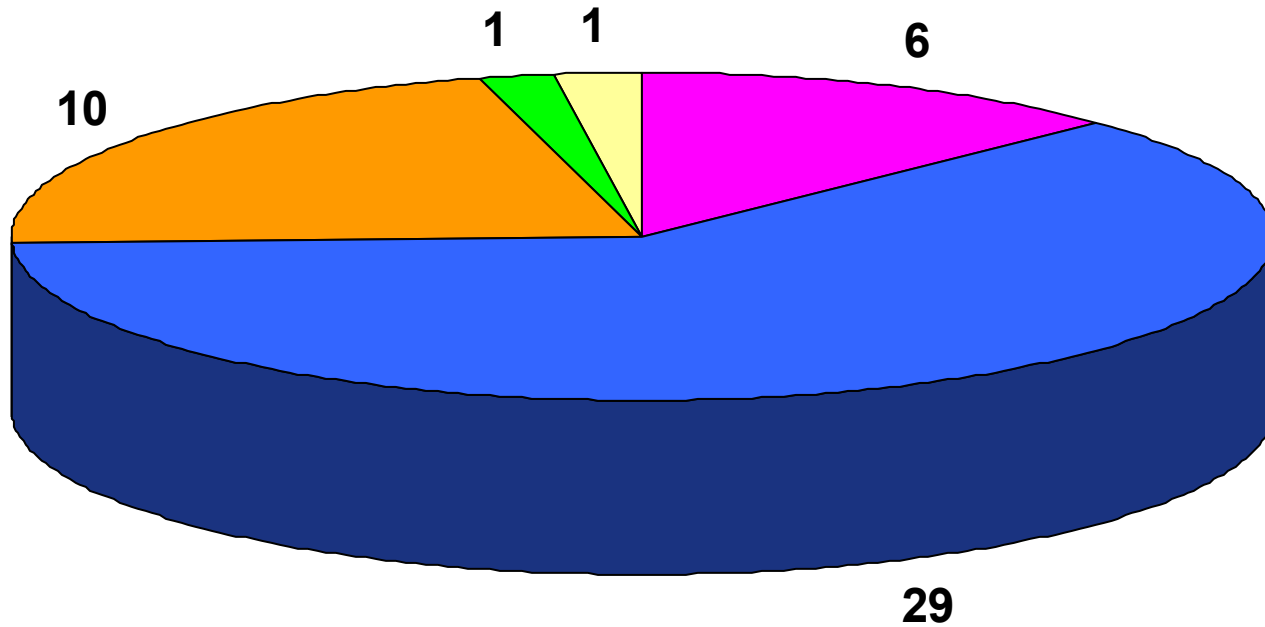
42 Respondents Reporting Gender

Age of Graduates

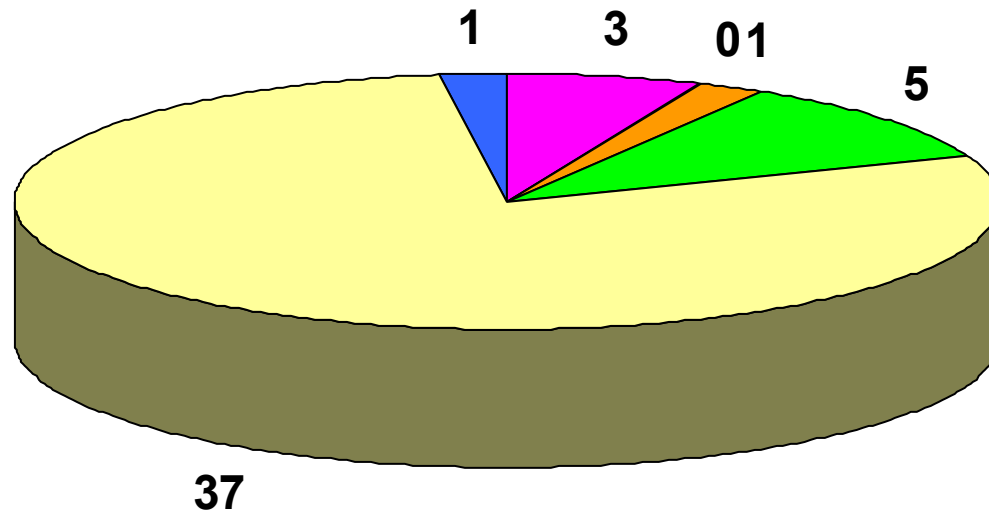

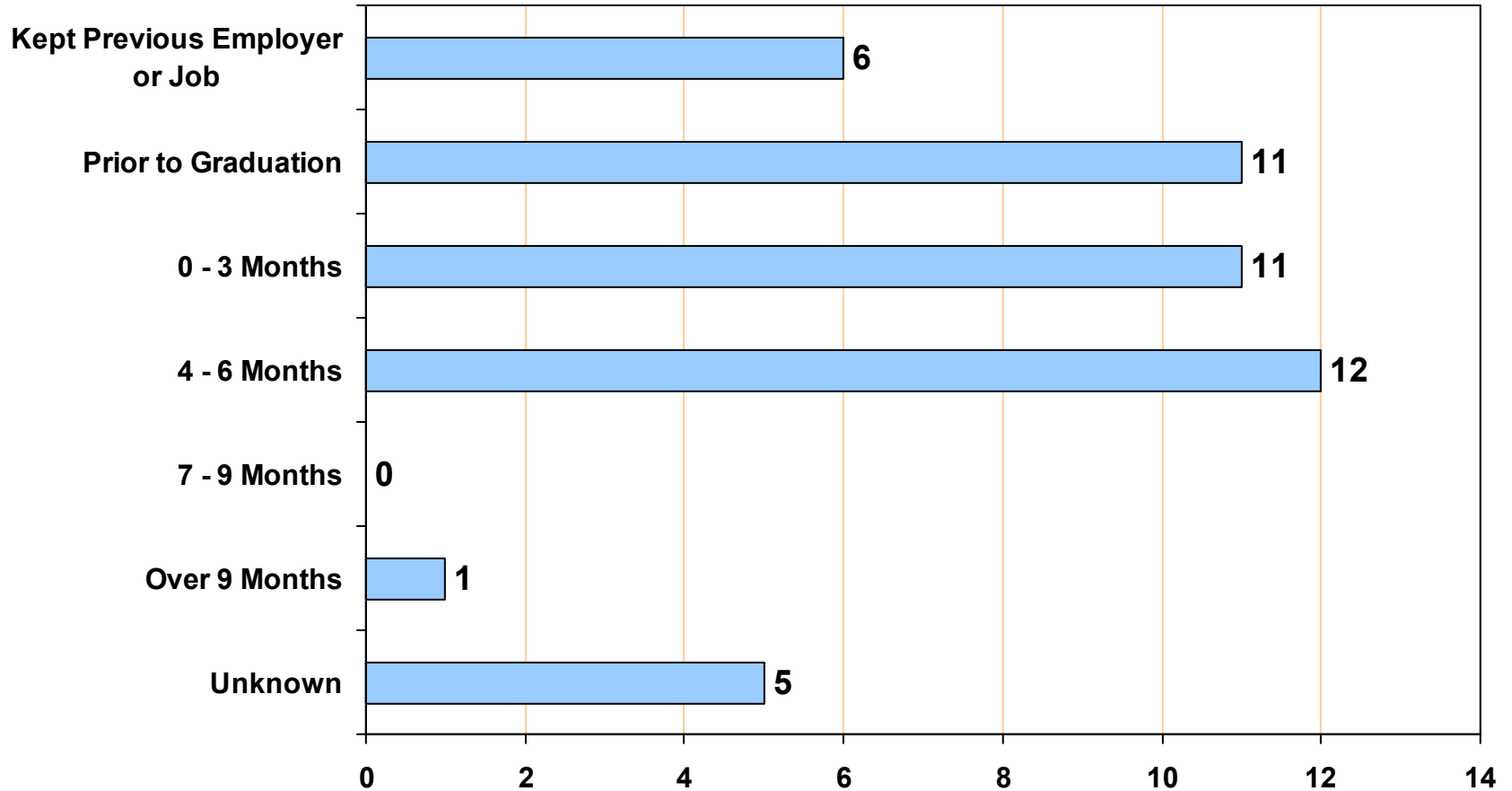

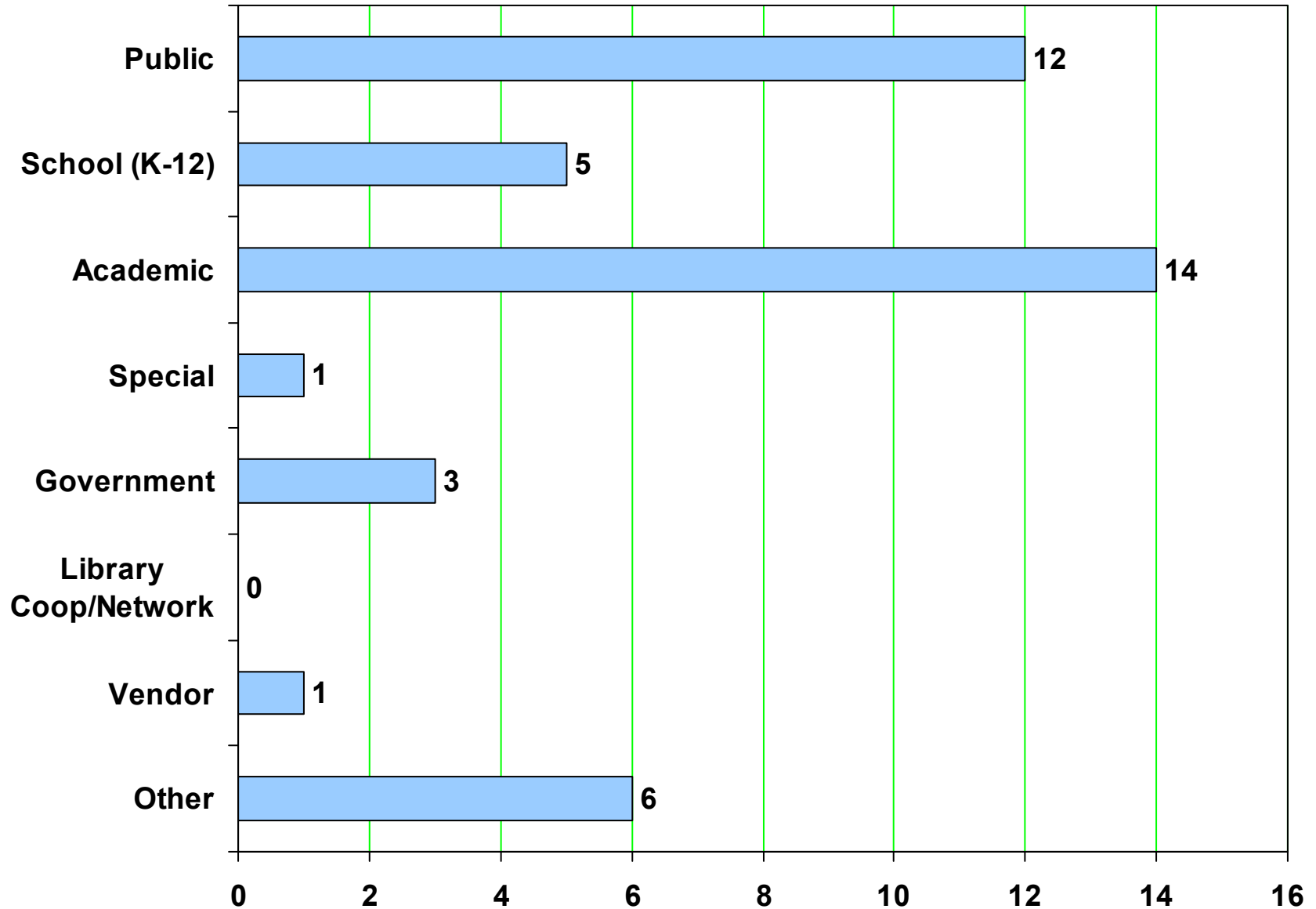
Time to First Employment

41 Reporting Full-Time Employment Information



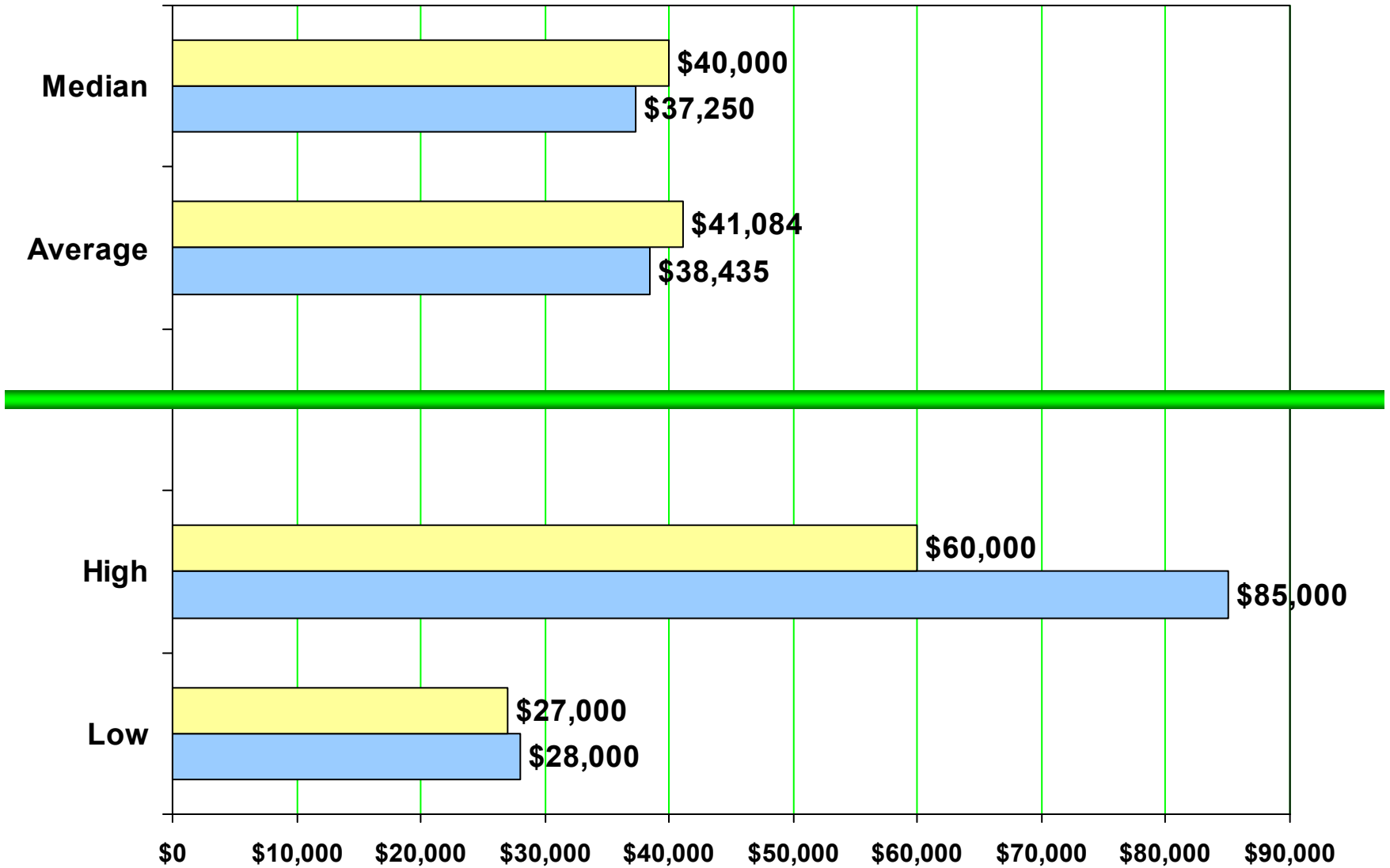
Employment by Type of Organization

42 Graduates Reporting Type of Organization



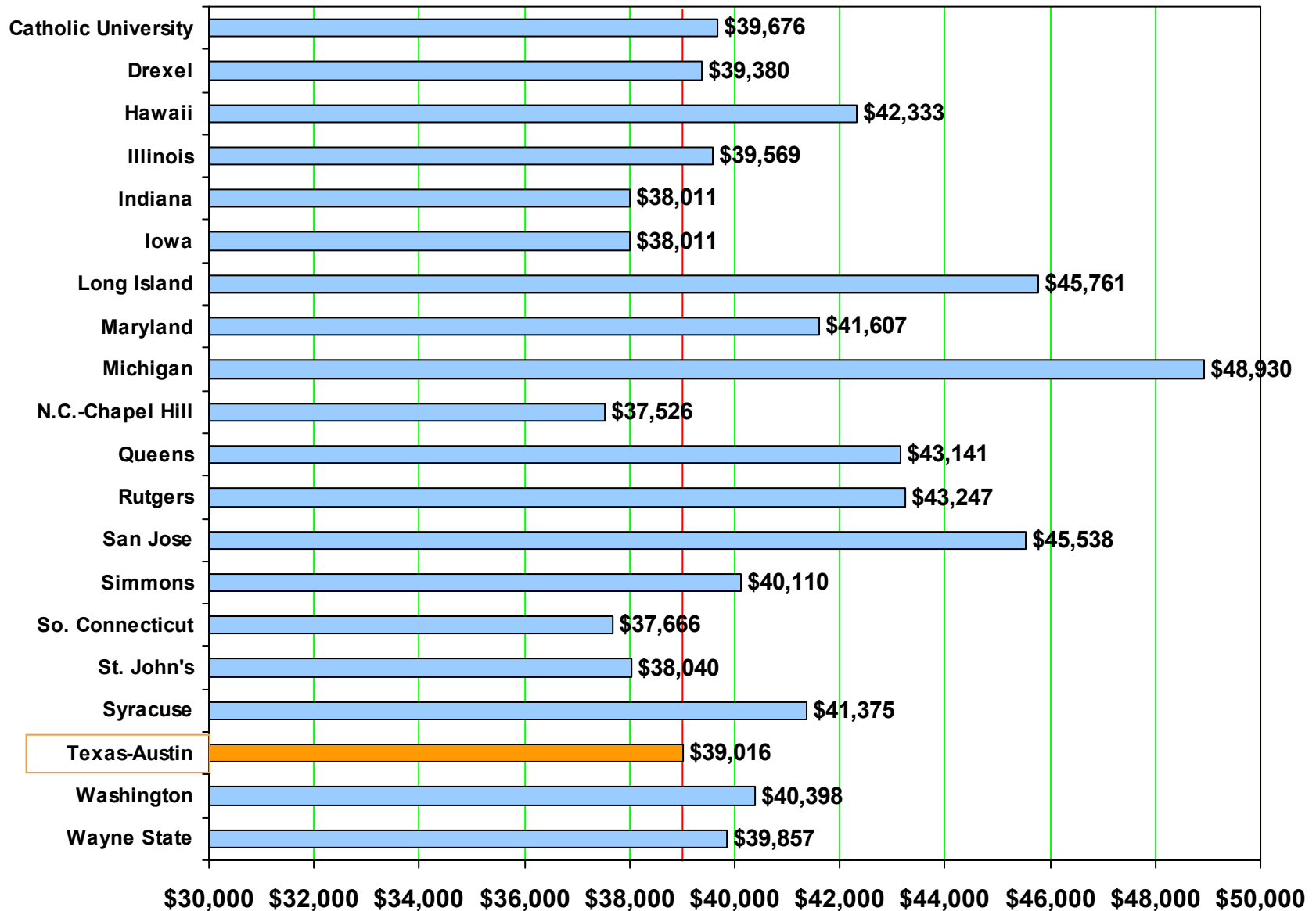
Salaries by Gender
